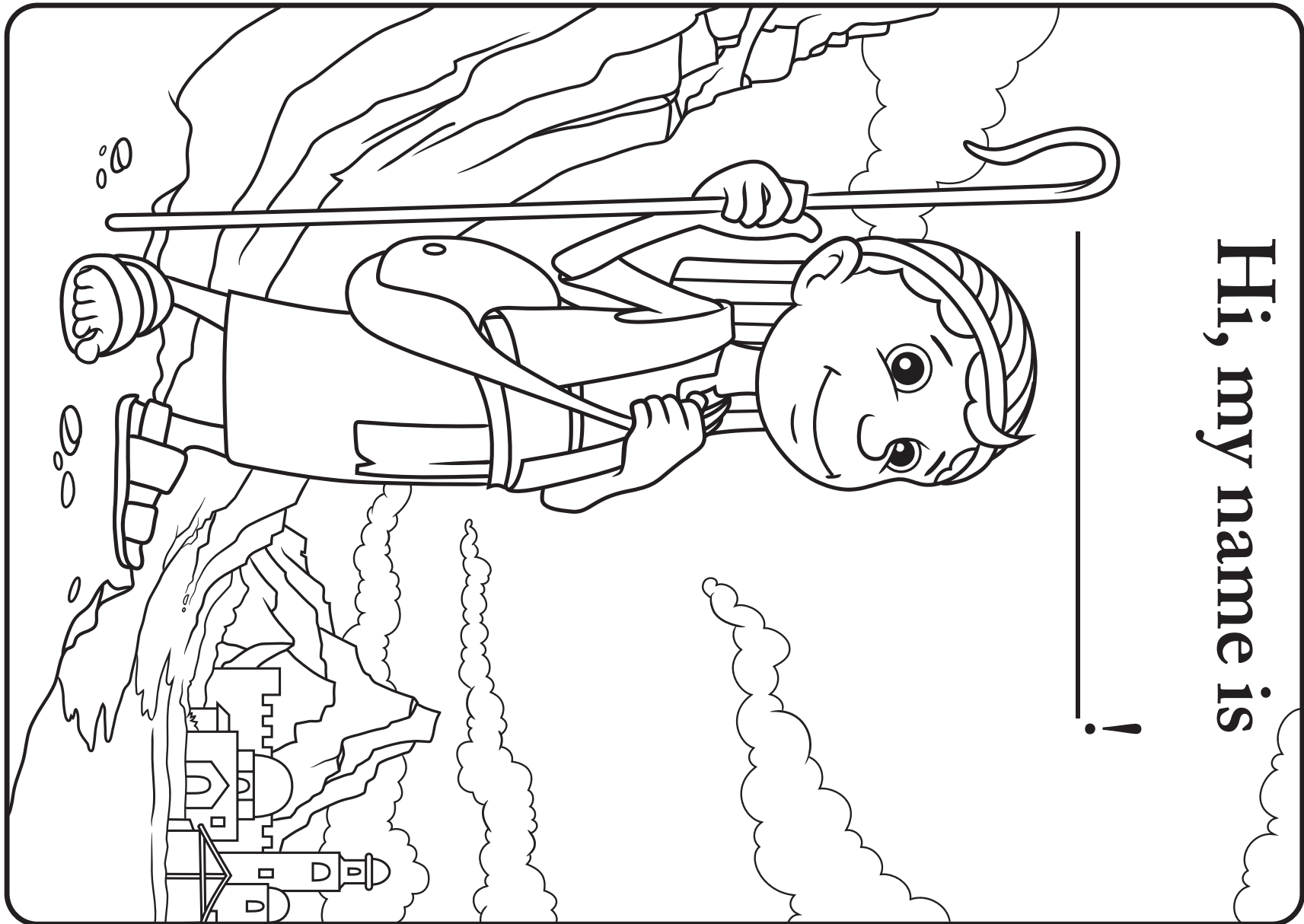

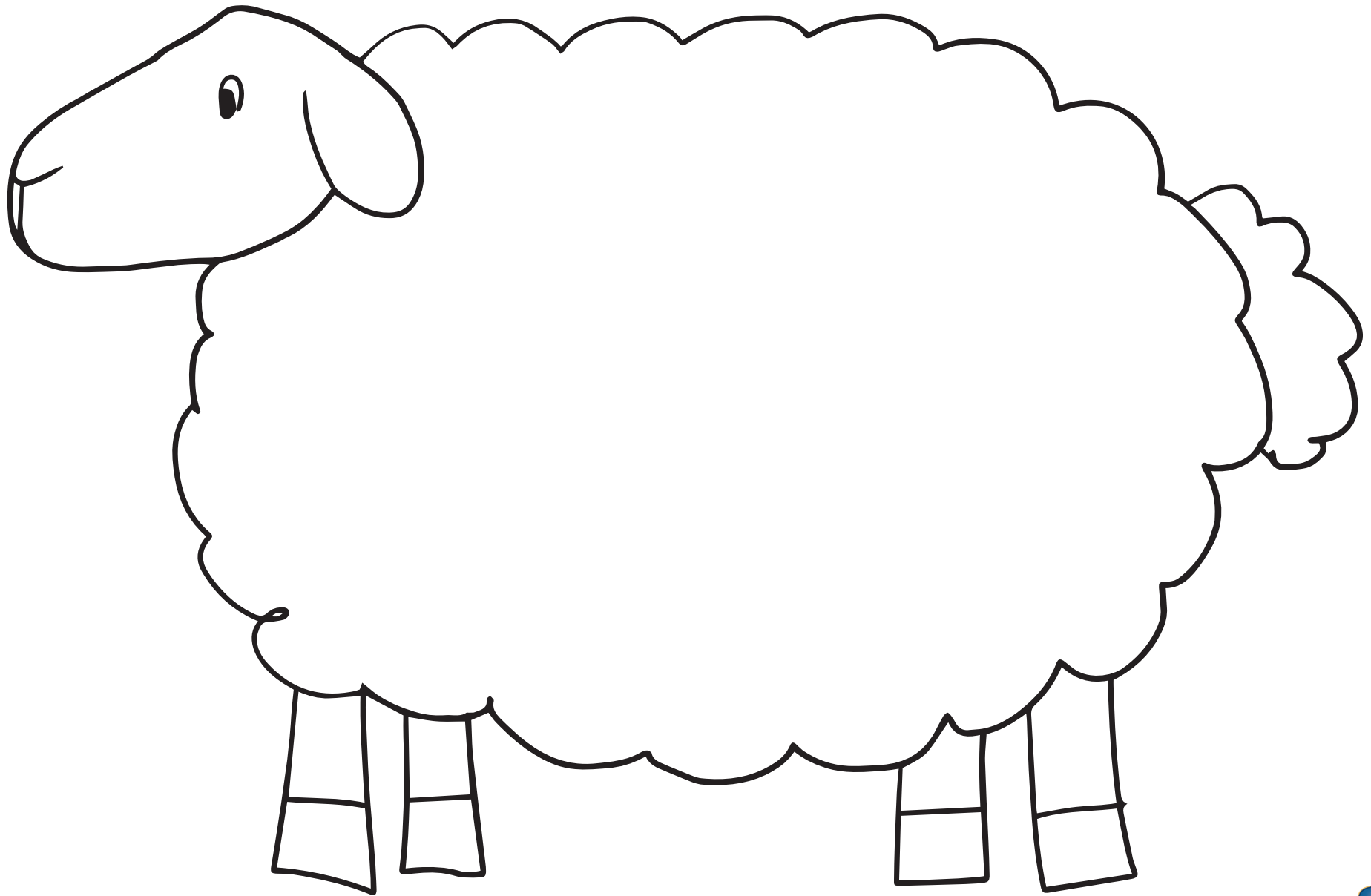

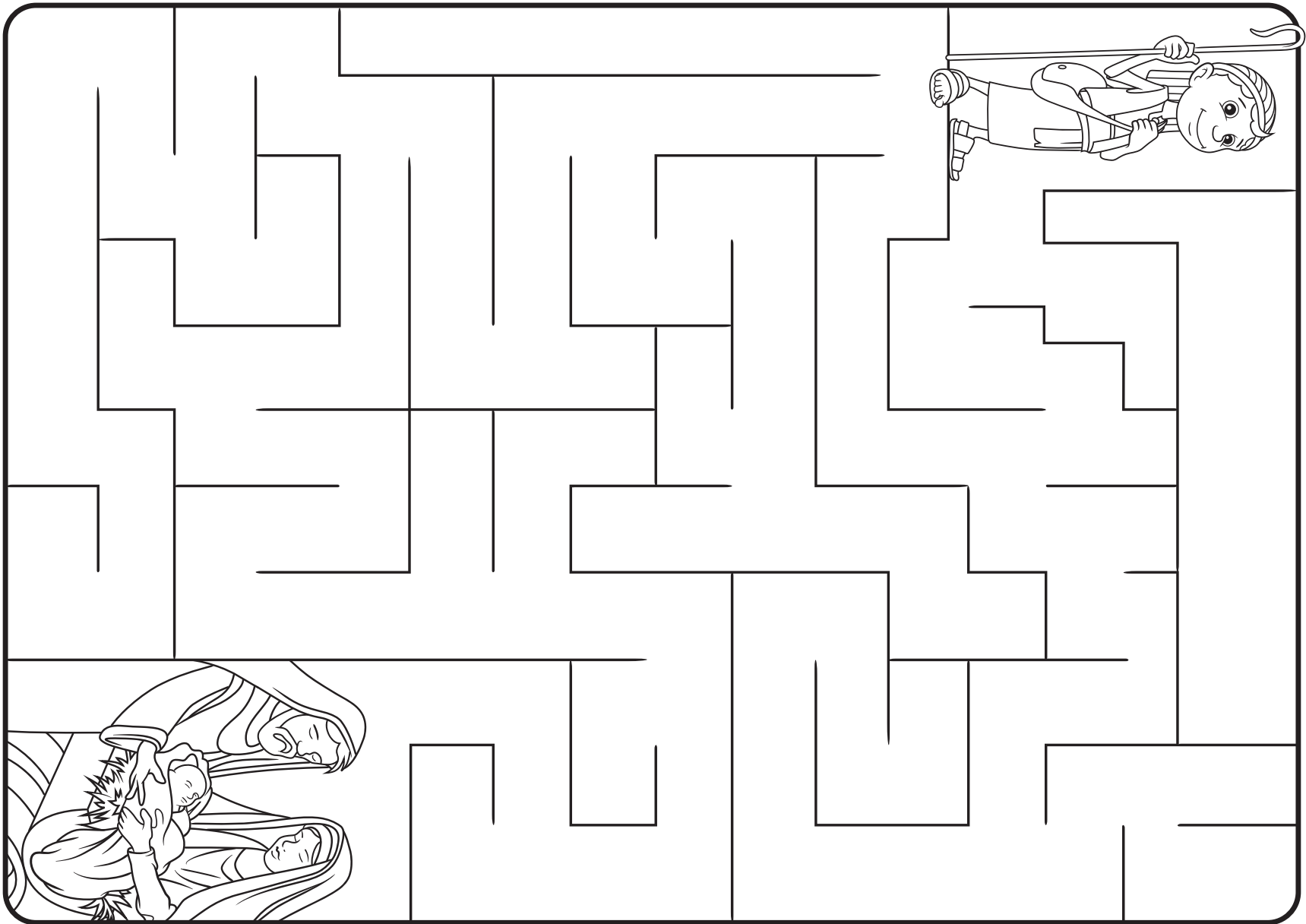

- ☐ I am in a place that goes round and round and makes things dry. (dryer)
